Part 3: Flute, Oboe, English Horn, Bb Clarinet

Part 4: Bb Clarinet, Bb Trumpet, Soprano Saxophone, Alto Saxophone

Part 5: Bb Trumpet, Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone, F Horn

Part 6: Bb Trumpet, Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone, F Horn

Part 7: Bb Bass Clarinet, Bassoon, Tenor Saxophone, Baritone Saxophone

Part 8: Bb Bass Clarinet, Bassoon, Baritone Saxophone

Part 9: Baritone Saxophone, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba

Percussion 1: Suspended Cymbal

Percussion 2 (Pitched): Glockenspiel

Percussion 3 (Pitched): Marimba

Difficulty of Parts:

*The greater the part number, the lower the notes are in the part. For example, Parts 5 and 6 could both be played by Trumpet. Think of Part 5 as "Trumpet 1" and Part 6 as "Trumpet 2."

*While the score is in C, all individual part files are transposed accordingly and in the correct octave for each instrument.

PROGRAM NOTE:

Just like a large group of fish is referred to as a "school," a large group of jellyfish are called a "bloom." This piece invites you to explore an underwater galaxy and imagine the alien-like, glow-in-the-dark (bioluminescent) beauty of jellyfish.
